Hi All,

An interesting exercise trying get the Order of Play sorted for Week 5 / 14th February of the U16 Girls.

Divisions 1 & 2 had to return to the pre Cup competition positions ... Doncaster return to Div 2 and Huddersfield return to Div 3. Doncaster had to withdraw due to a clash of competition and Huddersfield took their place in the Cup Round.

Sheffield B, Ben Rhydding B, Kingston upon Hull, Wakefield C & Halifax A all did not attend on 10th January so are demoted to Division below.

Divisions 6 & 7 return to Leeds Grammar School and can either play a 3 team competition on each pitch, or play the 5 or 6 team Round Robin, we had planned to use earlier, using both pitches.

4, 5, & 6 Team Orders of Play included on second page of the attachment.

PLAY OFF FINALS:

The Play Off Finals will take place on Week 6 : 13th March subject to Halifax Hockey Club being available & not required for YHL Senior League rearrangements.

Organisation for the Play Off Finals are a little different to previous seasons as we are trying out a new system if it doesn't work, or we don't like it, we will revert to the tried and tested previous system.

There are just 6 weeks of YYHL Hockey this season with no additional session for the Play Offs.... we plan for all YYHL Hockey to be completed by Easter as long as the weather allows us to do so + no additional costs for the extra session for the Play Off Finals as in previous seasons.

The Top 8 teams at end of play on 14th February will be invited to the Play Off Finals that are currently planned to be played at Halifax Hockey Club.

4 Teams in Div 1 + top 3 teams in Div 2 + top team in Div 3.

There will sessions for all the other teams that are not invited to the Play Off Finals as per the attached Order of Play.

For the first time the League Winner and the Play Off Champion will be the same team by design because of the way this year's competition will end.

Hope this all makes sense and explains how the Order of Play has been organised.
